A. Group - I (Arts, Humanities & Languages):

PROFESSOR:

- i. The candidate should have PhD qualification in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with a minimum of 10 publications as books and/or research/policy papers.
- ii. A minimum of ten years of teaching experience in university/college, and/or experience in research at the University/National level Institutions/industries, including experience of guiding candidates for research at doctoral level.
- iii. Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology – mediated teaching learning process.
- iv. A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS), set out in this Regulation in Appendix III.

OR

ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR

Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities / Colleges / Institutions.

2. PAY AND ALLOWANCES

Professor: The minimum pay of a direct recruit for the position of Professor shall be fixed at a stage not below Rs. 43,000/-per month in the pay scale of Rs. 37400-67000 with an AGP Rs. 10,000/-**(PB-IV)** and carry all admissible allowances as per State Government orders.

Associate Professor: The directly recruited Associate Professor shall be placed in the pay band 4 Rs. 37400-67000 with an AGP Rs. 9000/-**(PB-IV)**, at the appropriate stage in terms of the conditions of the appointment and carry all admissible allowances as per State Government orders.

Assistant Professor: Rs. 15,600-39,100 with AGP Rs, 6000/ **(PB-III)** and carry all admissible allowances as per State Government orders.
